

# WORCESTER MCR ELECTIONS

Voting for the members of the new MCR Committee will take place by secret ballot in the 4th week of this term. The MCR Committee consists, according to the MCR Constitution, of the following members: President, Treasurer, Social Secretary, Librarian, Oxford University Graduate Union (OUGU) and Franks Lectures Representative and Sports Representative. The post of Social Secretary may be held by two persons jointly.

All members of the MCR may vote at the elections and be candidates for MCR Committee positions. Nominations (accompanied by a manifesto if the candidate wishes) shall be made in writing to the present MCR Secretary, George Gerapetritis, supported by the signatures of the candidate, a proposer and a seconder (both members of the MCR) by **noon, Wednesday 2 February 1994**. If two candidates wish to serve jointly as Social Secretaries, both their nominations shall state their willingness to serve jointly.

Hustings, where the candidates can present their manifestos, will take place at **8.15 p.m. on Wednesday 9 February 1994**. Voting will take place on two days: the first, **9-10.30 p.m., Wednesday 9 February 1994** (immediately following hustings), and the second **12.30-2 p.m. and 7-8.30 p.m., Saturday 12 February 1994**. The voting as well as the hustings will take place at the Worcester MCR room.

A list of candidates, their manifestos and a list of members eligible to vote will be displayed at the MCR room the week before the elections. If there is only one nomination for a post (or joint nominations for Social Secretaries) there will be no ballot.

For any general queries or disputes as to a person's eligibility to stand or vote, please refer to the Secretary.
