The 2 motions are:

This MCR notes that:

1. The JCR has a voluntary charities budget, out of which they give money to local and national charities each term.
2. This is a nice thing to do as there are a lot of people less fortunate than ourselves.
3. The MCR currently does not have a provision for such generous giving to other people.
4. Recently the MCR Subscription fee of £8.40 was removed from our termly battels bill.

This MCR resolves to:

1. Introduce a maximum charge of £5 on MCR battels to go towards a termly charities budget.
2. Notify the MCR of this charge at the beginning of each term, and allow members to opt-out by Sunday 2nd week.
3. Collect nominations from members of the MCR each term of where they think the money should be allocated.
4. As a committee decide at the end of each term which charities will receive a donation, with emphasis placed on those who have a connection with the MCR, or are based locally in Oxford.

This MCR notes that:

Former/Current Members of Worcester College are welcome to apply for Associate Member status if they meet one of the following criteria:

1. Spouses and long-term partners (typically co-habitees) of MCR members;
2. 4th-year undergraduates reading Chemistry; *-determined by SCR ie course = 1 yr masters*
3. Previous JCR or MCR members who still have an academic connection to Oxford University or Oxford Brookes University or who are living and working in Oxford.

Currently Article I, Section B, Point 5 of the MCR Constitution reads:

5. When Associate Members cease to be integrally connected with academic life at the University, they shall cease to be eligible as such.

There is currently no method for checking the eligibility of Associate Members, so whilst they still pay their fees to college they will remain an Associate Member for as long as they wish.

This does cause problems for security, as currently Associate Members who have left are not required to return their U-Keys. There will soon be implemented a swipe card system where individuals can be deactivated centrally. However, the Security department will need notification of who needs to be deactivated each year, otherwise they will deactivate all Associate Members at the beginning of each year.

This MCR resolves to:

Hold an annual review of who is still eligible as an Associate Member of the MCR, and inform the Graduate Officer and Head of Security of the outcome.

Insert into Article I, Section B of the MCR Constitution:

6. The MCR Committee shall review the eligibility of every Associate Member during Michaelmas term of each academic year.
