A general MCR meeting will be held on Friday, February 24 at 7:00pm in the Grad Pad. Hustings will be conducted at this time, during which the candidates will present their objectives for the position they seek. Elections will be held immediately after hustings.

The MCR Committee is comprised of the following positions, all of which are open for election. Please contact current MCR Committee members for further details about position responsibilities:

President: represent the MCR to the College and the University; includes overseeing MCR projects, reforms, and student relations

Secretary: manage the workings of the MCR Committee; includes arranging MCR General Meetings, recycling, and charity donations

Treasurer: manage MCR accounts and annual budget; includes monitoring subscriptions, printing, and battels

Social Secretary: plan MCR social calendar; includes scheduling bops, guest nights, and the Garden Party

Computer Rep.: upgrade and maintain computer equipment; includes looking after network, software, and hardware

Sports Rep.: organize MCR sporting events; includes scheduling football, hockey, and MCR-SCR cricket match

Franks Society Rep.: organize Franks Society presentations

Graduate Committee Rep.: represent the MCR to the University Graduate Committee
